Eligibility and Instructions for Co-Packers



Who is it for?

Thank you for your interest in the Co-Packer Directory Program. We're thrilled you want to share your skills and experience in the Non-GMO Project Product Verification Program (PVP) with potential clients.

We understand there are many terms and scopes for your work in the products industry. You might consider yourself a co-packer, producer, manufacturer, co-manufacturer, facility, developer or other kind of facilitator in the industry.

This program is for producers of Non-GMO Project Verified products interested in manufacturing and/or enrolling additional products for brand owning companies with which they are not otherwise legally affiliated. If you are unsure how you fit in, you can read more about company roles in the PVP in the Non-GMO Project Verification Guide.

What is included?

The Co-Packer Directory is a page on the Non-GMO Project's website where approved co-packers may list their name, contacts and company information.

The program provides a platform to share information about your company and the services it provides. It helps you connect with potential clients interested in having *your* company manufacture or enroll *their* products for the PVP.

The description you include with your listing gives you the opportunity to express the types of products you may be able to enroll and how much of the manufacturing and PVP enrollment process you are prepared to take on for clients.

This directory is currently free and part of an ongoing pilot program. Rules and eligibility requirements, as well as the existence of the program, are subject to change at any time. You will be notified of changes at the email submitted within your program application. We also welcome feedback and hope that you will continue working with the Non-GMO Project as we consider other ways to provide information and connections for companies in our program.

Program Requirements

In order to participate in the Co-Packer Directory Program your company must:

- Complete a co-packer intake form, which includes:
 - Providing company and contact information.
 - Demonstrating the company currently manufactures a Non-GMO Project Verified
 product by submitting identifying information of at least one product you are copacking that is currently enrolled in the PVP (this will NOT be publicly listed on the
 website; the Non-GMO Project will only use this information to confirm eligibility).
- Complete a CO-PACKER DIRECTORY PROGRAM AGREEMENT.
- Submit a custom advertisement that follows Non-GMO Project guidelines and is subject to approval by the Project.
- Remain in good standing in all applicable areas of participation with the Non-GMO Project.
- Actively offer services that include manufacturing and/or enrolling products in the PVP on behalf of a brand-owning client.
